With large-scale upheavals and natural disasters threatening the peace, stability, and safety of so many worldwide, now might be a good time to remember the patron saints of the countries afflicted and request their assistance:

Cuba, which has suffered under Communist, atheistic oppression for decades, and which is one of our closest neighbors, places itself under the protection of *Nuestra Señora de la Caridad del Cobre*, or Our Lady of Charity.

Haiti, also a close neighbor, has endured a powerful earthquake once again. Their patron saint is Our Lady of Perpetual Help. Haiti is predominantly Catholic and is the poorest country in the Western Hemisphere, with most living in extreme poverty.

They specifically target Christians and women for persecution and cruel, inhumane treatment. Afghanistan is under the protection of St. Thomas the Apostle, who evangelized India and western Asia.

Our own United States has endured deadly wildfires and catastrophic hurricanes, and relief is unlikely for the near future. Our beloved patron saint is Our Lady of the Immaculate Conception.

Our annual Franciscan Tertiaries hike took place on Labor Day, Monday, September 6 at the Ledges Trail in Cuyahoga Valley National Park.

We studied the encyclical *Rite Expiatis*, written in 1926 by Pope Pius XI on St. Francis of Assisi. We focused on different aspects of Franciscan spirituality mentioned in the encyclical, such as *life according to the Gospel, the role of Divine grace, humility, the apostolate and St. Francis' love of creation*, followed by questions and group discussion. We concluded by praying the Canticle "Let all creatures praise the Lord" (Daniel 3). After the hike we met for lunch at Fisher's in Peninsula


We all had a wonderful time of Franciscan fellowship while enjoying God's gifts and hope to repeat the outing next year.


